

Memorials and Gifts Committee

July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026

During the past fiscal year St. John's received \$270 from six donors, memorializing Arlene Soldat, Bill Knop, Don Roberts and Aldona Kriauciunas.

These funds were designated by the donors or by the families of those honored for the Comfort Dog Program, The Music Fund, Youth Ministry, and for use where most needed by the church or school.

The financial report for the year includes:

Transferred to St. John's accounts	140
Fund balance 6/30/2026	\$6,249

The year end balance is \$6,249, of which \$1,536 has been designated for the Narthex Fund. The remaining \$4,713 has been designated for "where most needed" by the church and school.
